Swedish-Scandinavian Culture Center, Swedish House, Cairo, Egypt

Description and environment

Swedish House is a five story building in Shoubra al-Khema in Cairo. It is a meeting place for different cultures and has great possibilities to help children and youth in the most needing environment. It is tin minutes walk to Metro and 15 minutes by Metro to Tharir-Square.

The house consists of the following.

- The first floor will function as an internet cafe for young Egyptians and young people from other countries, mainly the foreign students living in the house.

- The second floor functions today as a day-care center for Muslim and Christian children between 3-6 years old. We have four employees, both Muslim and Christian, caring for appr 50 children. It is the one of very few day-care centers in Cairo that is none religious and mix children and employees from both religions.

- The third floor has six class rooms.

The fourth and fifth floors contains two apartments with three bedrooms each. One bedroom is for the manager and the rest, five bedrooms, will be for five foreign students for the three month courses in Arabic.

1- (A) Course in Modern standard Arabic

3 months courses in Arabic for foreign students are planned to start date in 1 September and 1 March Modern Standard Arabic is the language of newspapers and the media. It is used by educated people and Intellectuals. Our intensive course is for foreign beginning students to enable you to read and write as well as listen and speak.

(B) Course in Egyptian dialect

3 months courses in Egyptian dialect are planned to start date 1 December and 1 June .

Egyptian dialect is the most spoken dialect in Egypt and in Meddle East. Our intensive course will enable you to understand and speak Egyptian Dialect.

Structure of the course:

Lessons: 20 hours per week. Time frame: Classes are from Sunday to Thursday weekly from 9.00 am to 2.00 pm. 1 hour lunch. Practice: 10 hours per week teaching English to Egyptian students. Class size: 5-8 students Preparations: 10 hours per week on your own Academic teachers.
